Installation Instructions for Service Entrance Barrier Kit for Horizontally-Mounted 3VA55, 3VA65 or 3VA66 Breaker in a P5 Panelboard

This instruction sheet is to support the field installation of a Service Entrance Barrier Kit into a Siemens P5 Panelboard. Kit SEBPPVA2 is for a Horizontally-mounted 3VA55, 3VA65 or 3VA66 breaker. This covers both single and three phase panels, either top or bottom fed units.

- Lock off ALL power supplying this equipment before working on it.
- 2. Remove the panelboard front cover and deadfront.
- 3. Locate the Service Terminal End of the Service Main. This is the location to mount the Service Entrance Barrier.
- 4. Refer to Figure 1:


Position the Barrier Mounting Bracket (Item 2) onto the end of the Plastic Barrier opposite the straps, oriented with the Bracket tab facing the breaker, and secure to the barrier using the two #10-32 SEMS Screws (Item 4). Tighten each to 30 lb-in.


5. Refer to Figures 2 & 3:

Position the Service Barrier Assembly (Item 1) onto the Barrier Mounting Bracket (Item 2), oriented as shown, and secure it to the bracket using the two #10-32 Thread-forming Screws (Item 3). Tighten each to 30 lb-in.

6. Before energizing the panel, ensure that ALL connections have been properly torqued, that the service entrance barrier is in place and secure, that the deadfront is installed and that all fillers are in place.
